

SAFARI 62 LTD – CLIENT TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. Introduction

Safari 62 Limited is a duly registered tour and safari operator in Uganda. These Terms & Conditions govern all bookings, services, and agreements between Safari 62 and its clients. By confirming a booking, the client agrees to be bound by these Terms & Conditions.

2. Booking & Confirmation

- All bookings must be confirmed in writing (email, WhatsApp, or signed booking form).
 - A booking is only confirmed once a deposit or full payment is received.
 - Safari 62 reserves the right to decline any booking at its discretion.
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3. Payments

- Payment terms will be communicated at the time of booking.
 - Payments may be required in full or by installment.
 - All bank charges, transaction fees, and foreign transfer costs are the responsibility of the client.
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4. Cancellations & Refunds

- Cancellation fees apply depending on how close the cancellation is to the travel date.
 - Refunds exclude non-refundable park fees, permits, accommodation deposits, and third-party costs.
 - Safari 62 is not liable for delays or cancellations caused by force majeure (weather, strikes, government actions, etc.).
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5. Changes to Itineraries

- Safari 62 may adjust itineraries due to safety, weather, road conditions, or conservation requirements.

- Equivalent alternatives will be provided where possible.
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6. Travel Insurance

- Clients are strongly advised to obtain comprehensive travel insurance covering medical emergencies, evacuation, cancellations, and personal belongings.
 - Safari 62 is not responsible for uninsured losses.
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7. Health & Safety

- Clients must disclose relevant medical conditions.
 - Participation in safari activities is at the client's own risk.
 - Safari 62 complies with UWA, UTB, and national safety regulations.
